

MINUTE of MEETING of the WARE PRICE
COMMITTEE (GLASGOW) of THE SCOTTISH
POTATO TRADE ASSOCIATION held at
261 Wallace Street, GLASGOW, at 11.30
a.m. on WEDNESDAY, 25th NOVEMBER, 1970.

After a full discussion it was reported that the average Shopping
Price in Glasgow that day was:-

Red and White Ware - 24/- per cwt.

Supplies were adequate but best samples were short.
