

MINUTE OF MEETING OF WARE PRICE
COMMITTEE (GLASGOW) of THE SCOTTISH
POTATO TRADE ASSOCIATION held at
261 Wallace Street, GLASGOW at
11.30 a.m. on THURSDAY, 7th JANUARY,
1971.

PRESENT: Messrs. J. Robertson, J. Aitken, I.P. Fulton, E. Fulton,
A. Mathie, P. McDougall, A. Adair and G.G. Donald, along with
Mr. Gray of the Potato Marketing Board, Glasgow.

After discussion it was resolved to draw members attention to the
article on page 3 of the day's Glasgow Herald which pointed out
the dramatic effect on profits of a rise in overheads. This applies
to all firms whether large or small. The current rate for delivery
of goods from Glasgow Fruit Market by contractor was then 2/3d
per package. Bearing in mind the large increase in wages and other
oncosts last year and the increases already proposed for the current
year it was emphasised that every effort must be made to maintain
an average price of 28/- per cwt. for Red and White Ware delivered
if reasonable profitability was to be achieved.

A vote of thanks to the Chairman terminated the meeting.
