

REPORT on a MEETING of the ENTERTAINMENTS  
COMMITTEE of the SCOTTISH POTATO TRADE  
ASSOCIATION in 25 South Methven Street, PERTH  
at 2.30 p.m. on Friday, 6th FEBRUARY, 1987.

PRESENT: Messrs. P. Miller (Convenor), D.H. Lindsay, J.R. McArthur and  
A.S. Whitehead, with R. David Hunter (Secretary) and D. Blackmore  
(Assistant) in attendance.

APOLOGY: Mr. Blackmore reported receipt of an apology for absence from Mr.  
K.A. McKenzie (ex officio).

DINNER/  
DANCE: The Committee reviewed the outcome of the Function held in the  
Salutation Hotel, Perth on Friday, 16th January, 1987. In the overall  
view the Dinner and the service had been good, the verdicts on the Band  
being mixed. A draft Account tabled by Mr. Blackmore was considered.  
The Committee decided that refunds for the few absentees should not be  
offered and when finalising the Account to 5th April, 1987 it should  
include a note of totals received and disbursed in connection with the  
Horse Racing Game, resulting in the surplus of £106.94 donated to the  
Cancer Research Campaign.

In subsequent discussion of a Function in 1988 it was decided the  
Secretariat should arrange a provisional booking with the Salutation  
Hotel, Perth for Friday, 15th January, 1988. In respect of a Band, it  
was agreed Mr. Miller would ascertain how to contact the Jazz Group  
engaged at the recent function held by Auchterarder Golf Club.

GOLF  
OUTING: In the light of detailed information recently to hand from  
Blairgowrie Golf Club and pre-circularised to Committee Members, it was  
decided to accept the offered date of Thursday, 21st May, 1987. After  
discussion it was agreed the booking would provide for 15 four-ball  
foursome morning games on the Lansdowne Course commencing at 8.33 a.m.  
and 6 four-ball foursome afternoon games on the Rosemount Course  
commencing at 2.24 p.m.

It was further agreed the Secretariat ascertain the costs of the  
Association's usual catering requirements and prepare detailed ticket  
costs estimates for circularisation to the Committee prior to Council's  
next meeting on 6th March, 1987. It was envisaged that circularisation  
of details and booking forms (to include the Club's Memo of Rules on  
Dress etc.) to all Association Members should take place early in April,  
1987 with notification that the closing date for bookings and payments  
will be Monday, 4th May, 1987.

CURLING: Mr. Blackmore took note to write inviting Messrs. Crockatt,

to ask Mr. McClung to arrange the five South Rinks, for the forthcoming  
second leg of the Association's annual Curling Match, to take place in  
Perth Ice Rink at 3 p.m. on Friday, 6th March, 1987.
