

MINUTE of MEETING of the
ENTERTAINMENTS SUB-COMMITTEE of
S.P.T.A. held at 25 SOUTH METHVEN
STREET, PERTH, on FRIDAY, 4th JUNE,
1993.

PRESENT: Messrs. Peter Miller (Convener) and David Stewart (Association Vice-President), along with Mr. R.D. Hunter, the Secretary.

APOLOGIES: Apologies for absence were intimated on behalf of Messrs. Bob Doig (President), J. Logan Milne (Deputy Vice-President), Sandy Galbraith and Stewart Whitehead.

SUB-COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP: It was agreed to co-opt Mr. George Lothian of Galbraith & Roy Ltd. as an additional Sub-Committee Member.

1993 GOLF OUTING: Mr. Hunter tabled his Note of Account in respect of the 1993 Golf Outing held at Forfar Golf Club on Thursday, 20th May, 1993. The Account disclosed a deficit for the Outing of £54.45 which had been planned for in the Budget. The Account was formally approved. It was believed that the late planting season had accounted for the disappointingly low number of golfers who had participated. It was considered that Forfar Golf Club had proved an excellent venue and Mr. Hunter was instructed to make a provisional booking for a similar date for 1994 for 30 golfers.

ANNUAL DINNER/DANCE: It was confirmed the 1993 Annual Dinner Dance was to be held on Friday, 10th December, 1993. Mr. Hunter reported that there were provisional bookings for the function for both the Queen's Hotel, Perth, and the Huntingtower Hotel, Perth. Mr. Hunter reported that his enquiries indicated that charges for the Dinner at Huntingtower Hotel would be likely to be approximately £15.00 as compared with the approximate figure of £12.00 for the Queen's Hotel. Based on these figures it appeared that the cost of tickets for the respective venues would be:-

Queen's Hotel	-	£15.75
Huntingtower Hotel	-	£18.75

It was considered that the price of the tickets must not exceed £16.00. Mr. Hunter was instructed to speak to the Management at the Huntingtower Hotel to ascertain if they would be prepared to bring the price of the meal down to £13.00 per head. If they were prepared to do so, for a satisfactory meal, Mr. Hunter was instructed to confirm the booking for Huntingtower. If they were not prepared to do so Mr. Hunter was instructed to cancel the provisional booking for Huntingtower and to confirm the booking for Queen's Hotel.

Mr. Hunter was instructed to provisionally book Bill Wilkie's Band for the 1993 function. It was hoped that Bill Wilkie would himself be a member of the Band.

CURLING/

CURLING: Mr. Hunter confirmed that the Perth Leg of the Curling for the 1993/94 season had been booked for Friday, 4th March, 1994. Mr. Hunter stated that he did not have a date for the Edinburgh Leg of the Tournament. Mr. Hunter was instructed to invite Mr. George Lothian to make the necessary arrangements through Tom McClung who is a Director of Edinburgh Ice Rink. It was arranged that Mr. Stewart would let Mr. Hunter have the plinth of the Curling Cup in order that an additional band of silver be attached to make room for further engraving.

A vote of thanks to the Convener terminated the Meeting.
