

MINUTE of MEETING of ENTERTAINMENTS
COMMITTEE of S.P.T.A. held at 25
SOUTH METHVEN STREET, PERTH, at
10.00 a.m. on TUESDAY, 29th MARCH,
1994.

PRESENT: Messrs. Peter Miller (Convener), R. Doig, G. Lothian and C. Dickie.

APOLOGIES: Apologies were intimated on behalf of Messrs. D. Stewart and J. Hollywood.

ANNUAL GOLF OUTING: Mr. Hunter confirmed that the 1994 Association Golf Outing was booked to take place at Forfar Golf Course on Thursday, 19th May, 1994. After discussion it was agreed to fix the tickets for the Outing at the price of £35.00 (£15.00 for Forfar Club Members and non golfers). It was agreed that the price would include morning coffee.

It was agreed to alter the format of the Golf Match. In this connection it was decided to discontinue the North -v- South Match. The morning round would be three ball matches with the best net Stapleton Score winning the Beeson Cup. Concurrently there would be a sweepstake on the same basis at a price of £1.00 per ticket. It was agreed to arrange a tournament in the afternoon if there was sufficient support. The Secretary was instructed to seek with the booking forms an indication whether applicants would be proposing to participate in an afternoon tournament.

It was agreed to aim for at least 30 golfers (as booked). The Committee Members agreed to speak to Association Members and to urge them to attend.

The Secretary was instructed to endeavour to arrange for the first morning match to commence at 9.30 a.m. other than 10.00 a.m. and to book 8 starts for the afternoon.

ANNUAL DINNER/DANCE: Mr. Hunter confirmed that there was a provisional booking for the 1994 Dance to be held at Huntingtower Hotel on 9th December, 1994 and that Bill Wilkie's Band had been provisionally booked. After discussion it was agreed to go ahead with the Dance at Huntingtower as booked. Mr. Hunter was instructed to endeavour to book all of the accommodation in the Hotel for that night to be allocated by the Entertainments Committee. It was agreed that there would be a maximum number of 150 tickets issued (first come first served).

CURLING: Mr. Lothian undertook to make a booking for the Edinburgh Leg of the Curling Tournament for Tuesday, 6th December, 1994. Mr. Hunter reported that he was awaiting a Booking Form from Perth Ice Rink and would be making a booking for Friday, 3rd March, 1995.

It was agreed to add a charge of £1.00 per head to the Edinburgh Leg of the Match to cover the cost of engraving the Cup.
