

MINUTE of MEETING of the  
PRESIDENT'S COMMITTEE of  
S.P.T.A. held at PERTH ICE  
RINK at 11.30 a.m. on  
TUESDAY, 20th JUNE, 1995.

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PRESENT: Messrs. D. Stewart, A. Pullar, R. Doig, D. Harley, J. Marshall and R. McArthur, along with Mr. R. D. Hunter, the Secretary.

CHAIRMAN: The Association President, Mr. David Stewart, occupied the Chair,

APOLOGIES: Apologies for absence were intimated on behalf of Messrs. M. Beattie, V. Lumb and K. McKenzie.

INTERIM ACCOUNT: The Secretary took the Committee through the Interim Unaudited Income and Expenditure Account for the Association for the half-year to 30th April, 1995 and also the Interim Unaudited Accounts for the Press Fund for the same period. Copies of these Accounts had been previously circulated to Committee Members. The Secretary stated that in the main the Association's Accounts were in line with Budget in respect of both Income and Expenditure. He added, however, that it did appear that expenditure on photocopying and, to a lesser extent, postages, would be likely to exceed Budget at the year end. The Committee found the Accounts to be satisfactory.

There was general discussion with regard to the making of an appeal to Association Members to "top up" the Press Fund. It was agreed to recommend to Council of the Association that the Secretary makes an appeal to Members for voluntary donations in the hope of increasing the credit balance in the Press Fund to over £1,000.00.

This terminated the business of the meeting.
