

MINUTE of MEETING of S.P.T.A.  
PRESIDENT' SUB-COMMITTEE  
held at PERTH ICE RINK at 11.30  
a.m. on THURSDAY, 26th OCTOBER,

PRESENT: Messrs. D. Stewart, M. Beattie, B. Doig, V. Lumb, J. Marshall and R. McArthur, along with Mr. R.D. Hunter, the Secretary.

APOLOGIES: Apologies for absence were intimated on behalf of Messrs. A. Pullar, D. Harley and K. McKenzie.

DRAFT ASSOCIATION ACCOUNTS: Mr. Hunter took the Committee through the draft Association Accounts for the year to 31st October, 1995 which had been previously circulated. During discussion on the Accounts, Mr. Hunter reported that two extra copies of Association News Letters were sent to West Cumberland Farmers Ltd. at Abernethy and Scott & Newman Group at Shrewsbury. The Committee considered, as a matter of principle, that these two members were receiving preferential treatment and that they should be invited to make a payment to the Association for the extra copy of News Letter to cover the actual cost of the extra copies.

The Secretary was instructed to include in the 1994/95 Accounts the cost of the meeting of Council to be held later in the day, the cost of the members of the Arbitration Rules Working Party travelling to York on 13th November, the cost of purchasing the binders for the Members Book and an additional £100.00 to the Secretary for travelling expenses during the year.

During discussion on the draft Press Fund Account it was suggested that it might be beneficial to send to members along with the Subscription Notices in January a further copy of the Voluntary Donation Form.

This terminated the business of the meeting.
