

MINUTE of MEETING of the  
PRESIDENT'S COMMITTEE of  
S.P.T.A. held at PERTH ICE RINK  
at 11.30 a.m. on THURSDAY, 24th  
OCTOBER, 1996.

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PRESENT: Messrs. D.Y. Stewart, D. Harley, J. Marshall and R. McArthur, along with Mr. R.D. Hunter, the Secretary.

CHAIRMAN: The Association President, Mr. D. Stewart, occupied the Chair.

APOLOGIES: Apologies for absence were intimated on behalf of Messrs. A.M. Beattie, K.A. McKenzie, V. Lumb, B. Doig and A. Pullar.

ASSOCIATION ACCOUNTS: The Secretary tabled draft interim unaudited Accounts for the Association for the year ended 31st October, 1996. Mr. Hunter pointed out that the draft Accounts disclosed a surplus of £1,299.65. The Accounts were accepted. The Secretary was instructed to ensure that payment of that day's meetings in the Ice Rink and the cost of the Secretary and Mr. Hollywood travelling to London on 20th November to attend the meeting of Council of NASPM would be included in the final Account for the year. It was agreed that the Secretary would investigate the cost of purchasing improved dividers for the Members Book with the possibility of that cost also being included in the current year's Account. It was also agreed that it was likely that instructions would be given at the meeting of Council to be held later in the day for a Press Release to be issued. Mr. Hunter was instructed to endeavour to get the Account for that Press Release included in the 1995/96 Account.

INVESTMENTS: The secretary tabled a letter which he had received that day from Greig, Middleton & Co.Ltd., Stockbrokers, recommending the sale of the Association's £2,900.00 Treasury Conversion 9% 2000 Stock and re-investing the proceeds in purchasing Treasury 6 3/4% Stock 2004. It was agreed to recommend to the afternoon's meeting of Council that this advice be accepted.

This terminated the business of the meeting.
